

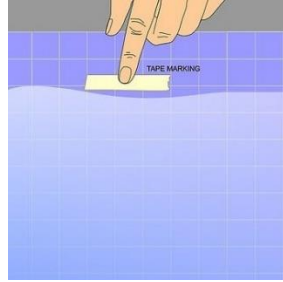


**5 Day Sit Test Instructions:**

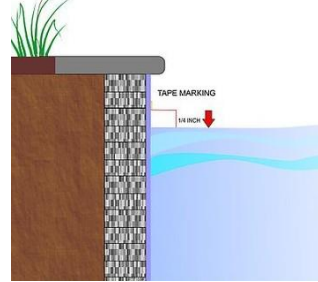
- Step 1: Fill pool & spa up to the middle of the tile line and mark both levels with a piece of tape.
- Step 2: If you have an auto fill, turn it off at the water supply valve to disable it.
- Step 3: Turn off all pumps and leave them off (unless freeze is imminent)
- Step 4: After 5 days, measure the distance between where the tape is, and where the water level is now, in both pool & spa.



Fill pool up to this line

At this point you should have 2 Marks: 1 where the pool/spa was filled to, and 1 where the water dropped to.  
Record the distance between the two marks here:

Pool Dropped to	___ Inches
Spa Dropped to	___ Inches

- Step 5: Fill Pool & Spa back to middle of the tile line and mark with tape.
- Step 6: Run the main circulation pump for 24 hours. **Do Not** run any water features and **Do Not** Heat pool or spa.
- Step 7: After 24 hrs. Turn off pump and measure the distance between where the tape is, and where the water level is now.  
Record that distance here:

Pool Dropped to	___ Inches
Spa Dropped to	___ Inches

**\*\*Your pool will need to be full to the middle of the tile line, clean & clear, and any cover or leaf catches have been removed for the leak specialist to continue with any further leak assessment/detection.\*\***

**FAQs:**

*Will rain effect the test results?*

Any rainfall can be calculated by weather forecasts and will be subtracted from the measurements.

*Will my pool turn green after being off for 5 days?*

If you begin the test with a full pool and balanced water chemistry, your pool will not turn green.

*Do I have to do the sit test if I am 100% sure I have a leak?*

Yes, this test is designed to help save time and money for both yourself and RPI. It also assists our technicians in advance to better pinpoint the area where your leak may be.
